

Clean Green Pakistan Initiative at Islamabad International Airport

ISLAMABAD (April 29, 2019):- In pursuance of the, "Clean Green Pakistan Initiative", Aviation Division has embarked on the campaign to plant trees at the Islamabad International Airport.
