EXPANSION/RENOVATION WORK AT QUETTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Karachi, December 21, 2015: Air Marshal (Retd) Asim Suleiman Director General Pakistan Civil Aviation Authority visited Quetta International Airport where he inspected the ongoing renovation / expansion project of Quetta international Airport. A comprehensive plan to renovate Quetta International Airport is underway to provide air passengers with better facilities and services. The plan envisages construction of two avio-bridges, Extension of concourse area, expansion of domestic and international arrival and departure areas to cater the double the capacity of both international and domestic departing and arriving passengers, Construction of new office block, car parking area for 500 cars, construction of incoming and outgoing roads to and from the airport building. During the visit he was also accompanied by Director Plans Civil Aviation Authority. Director General took complete brief on project and issued instructions for expeditious completion of the project in time. He also directed the consultants and contractors to ensure quality work and provision of all facilities for passenger convenience.
